

ABOUT THE CHALLENGE

The 2019 Minister's Climate Challenge is a statewide initiative open to all Queensland students from Year 3 to Year 10. The Challenge aims to encourage creative thinking when it comes to solving the climate problems of the future.

To take part in the Challenge, students must identify a local climate problem and brainstorm an innovative business or social change idea to solve it.

For students to successfully complete the Challenge, they must upload a written script for a pitch presentation.

Students can choose to work individually or in a group of up to 3 students. Students who complete the Challenge will have their efforts recognised through the receipt of a Certificate of Completion signed by the Hon. Leeanne Enoch MP, Minister for Environment and the Great Barrier Reef, Minister for Science and Minister for the Arts.

Submissions close at **1:00pm** on **May 10, 2019**.

- **EOI Submissions Due:** 1:00pm on April 8, 2019
- **Written Pitch Submissions Due:** 1:00pm on May 10, 2019
- **Showcase Evening:** 5:30pm on June 6, 2019 in Brisbane

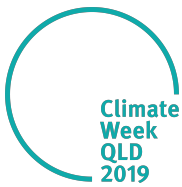
CERTIFICATES AND PRIZES

The Challenge will be divided into two categories:

- **Category 1:** Grades 3 to 6
- **Category 2:** Grades 7 to 10

Upon completion of the Challenge, students will receive a Certificate of Completion signed by Minister Enoch. Schools with 100% participation will be in the running for lucky draw prizes. Schools are encouraged to invite their local Member of Parliament to participate in the presentation of certificates to students.

5 teams (of up to 3 students in each) will be flown to Brisbane for a 3 day business bootcamp with Fiftysix Creations, mentoring from world class business leaders and a VIP Breakfast hosted by Minister Enoch. On Day 3, Finalists will present to a Live Audience and a Panel of Elite Judges.



REGISTRATION

Students must register via the ministersclimatechallenge.com.au website.

Each student must register, whether they are working in a group or individually. This allows for each student to complete the Challenge and receive their certificate. (A group of 3 students would each separately upload the same version of the script they created).

SCHOOL WORKSHOPS

Fiftysix Creations will visit up to 100 Queensland Schools to share information about the Challenge and provide feedback to participating students. The school workshops have been sponsored by the Queensland Government.
